

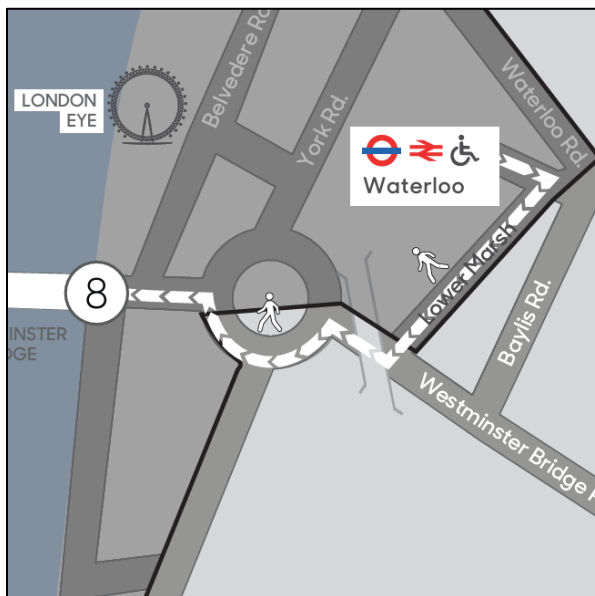
WHITE 8 ENTRANCE

Getting to Your Entrance

Your entrance will **open at 8:00pm** and **close at 10:30pm**. Please ensure you arrive in plenty of time before your entrance closes. To access the **White 8** entrance, you must arrive via **Waterloo Station** as other routes will be restricted or closed, and this may lead to a delay in your arrival.

Road and footpath closures will be in place across central London from 2pm on the 31 of December. You should plan to use the Underground and National Rail services to reach Waterloo Station and the White 8 entrance. Start planning your journey using the [TfL](#) and [National Rail](#) websites.

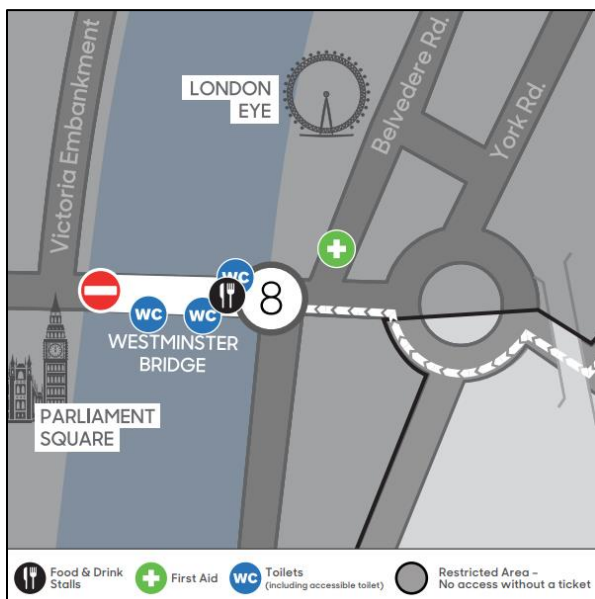
Start planning your journey on:

Mainline & Underground:
South Western Railway.
Bakerloo, Jubilee, Northern or
Waterloo and City Lines

Walking directions: Exit
Waterloo Station via EXIT 1
(Westminster Bridge Road)
and turn RIGHT. Continue
straight and follow the road
round to the LEFT onto Spur
Road. At the end of the road
turn RIGHT onto Lower Marsh.
At the bottom of Lower Marsh,
turn RIGHT onto Westminster
Bridge Road. Once you get to
the Crowne Park Plaza, go
round this to the LEFT and
follow Westminster Bridge
Road to Westminster Bridge.

This is around a 10-minute walk. Be sure to observe instructions from stewards and signage from the station exit.

Welfare Facilities
